THE HOMWOOD REPATRIATION SERVICE

This service provides all that is necessary for a
Repatriation throughout the World.

The Homewood Repatriation Service includes:

We are experienced in all aspects of repatriation throughout the world for foreign nationals who have died in England, and also in receiving the remains of UK nationals who have died abroad, back to England.

With our Repatriation Service we will help with the following (please see overleaf for costs):

Making the arrangements as needed, to include liaising with third parties such as the Funeral Director in the destination country and the coroner.

Booking the flight (cost will be advised at time of need and is in addition to our services).

Bringing the Person who has died into our care.

Embalming and dressing, together with visits to our Quiet Room at our Funeral Home if required.

Transport of the Person who has died, in a suitably wrapped and Zinc lined coffin (to meet airline requirements) to a London airport.

Collating and preparing the required paperwork.

Some countries require us to obtain permission for the repatriation before the Deceased person leaves the UK, and if appropriate we will visit the Embassy on your behalf.

Should you wish for your loved one to have a service prior to their journey home, we can arrange this.

A Funeral Service prior to the repatriation is not included within our standard Repatriation Service costings, and will involve additional professional fees and the necessary disbursements.*



If you would like us to arrange a repatriation, we will require the following information from you before we can book the flight:

- The Deceased's passport.
- The name, address, telephone number and email address of the Funeral Director at the destination country.
- One original Certified Entry of Death or one original Interim Death Certificate if the Coroner is carrying out an inquest.

Arranging a Funeral service prior to the Repatriation

All repatriation costs and disbursements* (if any) must be paid in full with cleared funds, no later than the day before the deceased person is to be repatriated.

Please note:

A funeral service is required prior to the deceased making the journey home, there will be additional professional fees and disbursements payable. An individual written quotation for this service will be provided as soon as the details are known. Transport to another airport may incur additional costs/fees.

*Disbursements are fees that we pay on your behalf to third parties.
